Dear colleagues and friends, this year the 6th edition of the international congress entitled: "Shoulder surgery: the experts question themselves" will take place in virtual mode due to the pandemic. 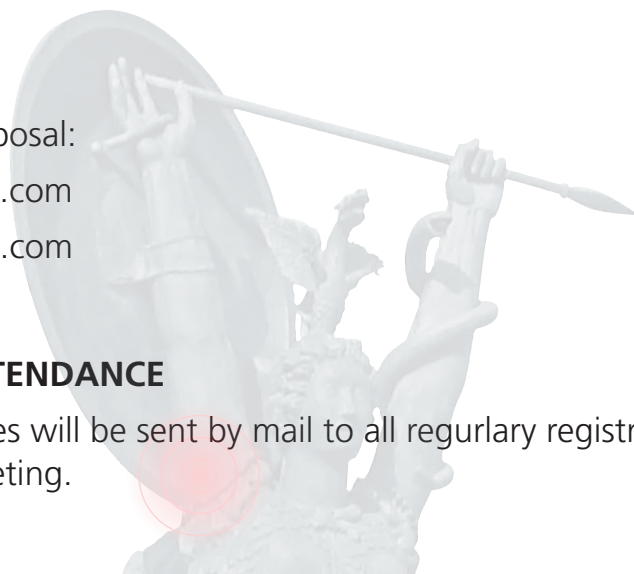
